Second Chances SA is a non-profit volunteer organisation committed to restoring hope in the lives of prisoners, their families and their communities across South Australia.

Our programs are custom-designed to equip them, especially **prisoners' kids (PKs)** to create better futures for themselves.





PK FAMILY CARE

Reaching the invisible victims of crime

PK Family Care responds to the unique needs of children and families with a parent in prison. The team provides home visits, school uniform packages, support, advocacy and agency referrals – all with the goal of strengthening families and keeping PKs out of the criminal justice system.



PK MENTORING CAMPS

Teaching life skills and values to prisoners' kids

PK Mentoring Camps are custom-designed for the children of prisoners. Each year, we run multiple camps for primary and high-school aged PKs – creating opportunities for mentoring, character development and building community with peers facing similar issues.

PK BIRTHDAYS

Keeping parents and PKs connected



Birthdays are an important occasion in the life of children. For those with a parent in prison, birthdays can be a time of sadness or fear that they have been forgotten. **PK Birthdays** provides birthday presents to remind children they are valued and loved by their imprisoned parent on their special day.

CHRISTMAS ANGELS

Bringing joy to children of prisoners

Christmas can be a lonely time for children when a parent is imprisoned. Each year, **Christmas Angels** provides over 550 PKs with two brand new presents from their imprisoned parent during Christmas visiting times – strengthening families and building self-worth.



BRINGING HOPE

Offering the chance to change



Bringing Hope is an in-prison volunteering program. Each week, accredited **Second Chances SA** volunteers visit prisons right across South Australia – providing friendship and practical support including banking and property storage.

RESTORING HOPE

People who commit crime and enter prison are already in a state of hopelessness. If we do not restore them with hope, they will return to society unchanged – leaving the cycle to continue with their children.
